- Must have full GWO basic training, or be willing to obtain.
- Must be able to pass D&A testing on-site on a regular basis.

- Be able to physically climb towers and access turbines parts (internally) to carry out maintenance tasks.
- Be willing to travel to multiple sites throughout AU/APAC as required.
